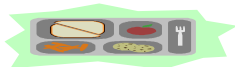


LOST AND FOUND

Travelling With Children This Summer

This is a friendly reminder that while you're travelling this summer with your family, make sure that everyone is protected properly!

California law states that children have to ride in a booster until they are **8 years old**. However, they are safest riding in a booster seat until they are 4 feet, 9 inches tall.

Accidents can happen at **any time**. Make sure that you are prepared with proper child safety seats in every vehicle your child rides in while travelling. Have a fun and safe summer!
